WHEREAS an inquisition hath this day been held upon view of the body of
Albert Johnson
who, came to his death from bullets fired by a Police posse
while endeavouring to effect his arrest for the wounding of
Constable A.W.King and the murder of Constable E.Millen,
both of the R.C.M.Police
and now lies dead in the R.C.M.Police Guardroom at Aklavik, N.W.T.

THESE ARE THEREFORE TO CERTIFY, that you may lawfully permit the body of the said
Albert Johnson
to be buried; and for your so doing this is your warrant.
