*Description of Albert Johnson
from an examination made at
Aklavik, N.W.T. Feb. 20th 1932.*

MAN KNOWN AS ALBERT JOHNSON, FROM HIS VARNISH
this date :

Height, 5 ft. 9 in. to 5 ft. 9½ in.

Chest, 34 inches.

Estimated weight, 145 to 150 pounds.

Light brown hair, beginning to recede on forehead,
light brown beard and mustache; beard and mustache
less than 1 month old.

Pale blue eyes, snubbed, up-turned nose; moderate
prominence of cheek bones; ears definitely lobed;
low-set and close to head.

Small wart or mole, 2 inches to left of spine, mid
lumbar region; this is only natural mark on body.
There are no operation scars or evidences of old
fractures.

Apparent age, 35 to 40 years.

Teeth: Well cared for, numerous fillings, though ob-
viously neglected for a period of some months.

Left upper jaw: Third molar and wisdom tooth extra-
cted; silver filling second molar, gold filling second
incisor.

Right upper jaw: First molar extracted, also third molar
and wisdom tooth extracted. Second molar large cavity,
anterior surface where filling has dropped out, bicuspid
also extracted.

Left lower jaw: Second and third molars extracted.

Right lower jaw: Bicuspid crowned with gold to which
is attached gold bridge reaching back to third molar
which is also gold crowned; wisdom tooth extracted.

Feet approximately 9½ inches long.
