Re: Patrol Report - Aklavik to Arctic
Red River. December 18th. 1931.

I have the honour to report that, acting on your instructions, I left Aklavik at 7.15 A.M. of December 18th. 1931 accompanied by Special Constable J. Bernard with his own team of dogs.

I arrived at Arctic Red River at 5.00 P.M. of the 19th. December 1931 and reported to Constable E. Millen, in charge of that Detachment.

I have the honour to attach hereunder copy of Patrol Diary :

December 18th. 1931. Reg.No. 10211 Const. A.W. King & S/Cst. J. Bernard with 5 dogs left Aklavik at 7.15 A.M. and made camp at cabin of Tom Trone on the Big River at 8.00 P.M. Mileage 45 miles.

December 19th. 1931. Left camp at 7.00 A.M. and arrived at Arctic Red River at 5.00 P.M. Mileage 45 miles.
